

**SEYMOUR QUILTERS GUILD
BLOCK OF THE MONTH**

**MAY 2023
DRUNKARD'S PATH**

Attached separately, you will find the Drunkard's Path template.

These pattern pieces will make a 6½" square. You will need 4 squares to make a 12½" x 12½" block.

On each pattern piece, match the sides along the CURVED edge. Pinch. Fold again and pinch, with right sides together pin the pieces together. Match the sides evenly and pin.

- Using a 1/4" seam, sew three or four stitches, adjust the fabric so the edges are even, sew three or four more stitches, adjust the fabric. Continue to the end of the seam. The curves are bias edges, so do not pull the fabric as you adjust. Press away from the quarter circle.
- Each block does not need to be made of the same fabrics. Just select two for your block to make the 12½"x 12½" block scrappy.
- Once you have made the four blocks, join them together to make the required 12½" x 12½" finished block.
